

Smalls Acts That Give Back – Nominate a Class Act Campaign

- 3. Campaign Period:** Entries will be accepted via online entry, mail, or in branch beginning at 9:00 AM EST on Wednesday, June 17, 2026 and ending to 11:59PM EST on Friday, July 31, 2026.
- 4. How to Enter:** The Campaign must be entered by submitting an entry using the online form. These forms can be found on JDCU.com or available in branch or through mail upon request. The entry must fulfill all Campaign requirements, as specified, to be eligible to win a prize. Entries that are incomplete or do not adhere to the rules or specifications may be disqualified at the sole discretion of Jeanne D'Arc Credit Union. YOU may enter only once. YOU must provide the information requested.
- 5. Prizes:** A total of six (6) winners will be chosen over the course of the campaign. One (1) \$500 winner, two (2) \$250 winners, and three (3) \$100 winners. These winnings will be presented in the form of an Amazon® gift card. No cash or other prize substitution shall be permitted. The prize is nontransferable. If Winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim the prize within 10 days from the time award notification was sent, or fails to timely return a completed and executed declaration and release as required, the prize may be forfeited and an alternate Winner selected.
